The Board has past new regulations for **High Altitude Flying**. These rules are being put into place by the Board of SVF due to recent violations to see and avoid and flying WITHOUT SPOTTERS. Motion 1- Continuous high altitude flying

Continuous high altitude flying is prohibited at all times at the SVF field. Pilots are prohibited from engaging in sustained high altitude (above 400 feet) flight, and the minimum penalty for violating this rule will be suspension of flight privileges for the remainder of the day. This rule will be enforced at the discretion of an SVF Board Member or Officer. Further violations of this rule may be subject to additional sanctions and penalties at the discretion of the Board. 1) Lou Pfeifer 2) Andrew Schear

Motion 2- DVT Tower call regarding UAV sighting by full scale pilot

A violation of the high altitude flying rule accompanied by a phone call or other notification from the DVA tower of a controlled airspace altitude sighting by a full scale aircraft of a UAV will subject the pilot of said UAV/RC aircraft to an immediate 30 day suspension at a minimum. The SVF pilot involved in the incident will be required to appear at the next SVF Board meeting for a discussion of the incident. 1) John Geyer 2) Frank Moskowitz

Motion 3

Every pilot flying at the SVF field MUST have a spotter at all times while in the air. A pilot flying without a spotter may be subject to disciplinary action by the SVF Board of Directors. A second offense of the spotter rule by the same pilot on the same day will result in that pilot being asked to cease flying for the day and he/she will be asked to attend the next SVF Board meeting to review and discuss the rule violation. The only exception to this rule is: If a member is the only pilot at the field, they MAY fly an aircraft with a wingspan of NO more than 60", either electric or fuel. TURBINES OF ANY SIZE ARE EXCLUDED FROM THIS RULE. Pilots flying by themselves under this exemption are STILL required to abide by "See and Avoid Rules" (AMA Section 540-D).


