Meeting Open: President Moskowitz called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM at the SVF field. He read a portion of John Gerhardt's Facebook post to the club regarding the highly successful Winter Warbirds event. There were 107 registered pilots at Winter Warbirds, 40 of which brought turbine powered jets. Mr. Gerhardt acknowledged the assistance of John Geyer, Charlie Beverson, & Mike Peck for working registration; Ken and Brian Rhoads for being the Air Boss; Brian Rhoads for putting together a massive member volunteer field cleanup crew; and Tony Quist for handing the preregistration and data capture. President Frank also recognized the many SVF members that worked the entry gate for three days.

The Sun Valley Fliers organization thanks all of you, including the many members that worked tirelessly to clean up the field prior to the contest, as well as John Gerhadt, the Contest Director. The noteworthy success of the event belongs to all of you.

<u>Secretary's Report:</u> The Jan. 6, 2024, club meeting minutes were approved as written and published.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Oliver Heinen reported on the amount of funds in the club treasury. The income from the Winter Warbirds event was being presented to the treasurer later today and was expected to be substantial. The report was approved as presented.

<u>Membership Director's Report:</u> Tony was not present at the meeting, but President Frank noted that the timeframe for member renewals at last year's cost has now expired.

<u>Safety Officer's Report:</u> Kenny Rhoads had no report, and thanked all members present at the meeting for flying safely. Kenny has written & submitted a letter to all SVF members regarding their personal liability when operating models at the SVF flying site. The letter will be published in the next Slow Roll newsletter, and is highly recommended reading.

IT Update: Bobby Santoro is working on the rollout of the new SVF website.

Old Business:

- 1. Ramada permitting is still in progress. Our Civil Engineer, Steve Bargeloh, is working with the City of Phoenix to get the permit approved. The reviewer has asked for additional information before considering approval of the permit.
- 2. The FAA had issued a Remote ID Authorization letter for the SVF field area and additionally just recently approved our FRIA status. Model airplanes flying within an approved FRIA location will not be required to have remote ID.
- 3. After the new ramada is built, the SVF will offer to sell the pop-up canopies to our members at \$75 each.

New Business:

- 1. The SVF Administrative Actions Schedule requires the appointment of a nominating committee to find club members willing to run in the next election for Officer positions and half of the Board of Directors positions. The committee is to be comprised of one current SVF Board member, two non-Board SVF members, and is chaired by the Club President. John Geyer volunteered to be the Board member on the committee and will work to recruit two non-Board members to serve on the committee. In April, the results of the work of the nominating committee will be announced. A ballot will be created after all nominees are known, and the election will be in May.
- 2. President Frank has ordered a 13' X 13' popup for the kitchen area identical to the one used by John Gerhardt during the Winter Warbirds event.

50/50 Raffle: The 50/50 raffle prize of \$44 was won by Cruz Hope. Congrats, Cruz.




SVF PILOTS HALL OF PLANES
